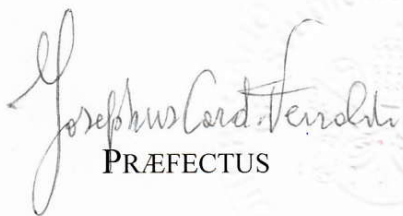

STATUTA

FACULTATIS THEOLOGIAE CATHOLICAE
APUD UNIVERSITATEM KAUNENSEM VYTAUTI MAGNI



Teologijos-filosofijos fakultetas Lietuvos universitete Kaune įsteigtas 1922 m. balandžio 12 dieną. Fakultetas Vatikano katalikiškojo ugdymo (seminarijų ir studijų institutų) kongregacijos (*toliau* – Kongregacija) kanoniškai patvirtintas 1928 m. balandžio 19 dieną. Kai popiežius Pijus XI patvirtino šį nutarimą ir įsakė vykdyti, ta pati Kongregacija, remdamasi 1928 m. birželio 15 dienos dekretu „*Lithuaniae antistites*“, paskelbė, kad Kaune yra kanoniškai įsteigtas Teologijos-filosofijos fakultetas, turintis teisę teikti teologijos ir filosofijos akademinis laipsnius. Jam buvo suteiktos ir kitos privilegijos, kuriomis naudojasi Apaštaly Sosto įsteigtos analogiškos institucijos.

Facultas Theologiae – Philosophiae in Universitate Lithuaniae die XII mensis Aprilis A. D. MCMXXII in urbe Kaunas erecta est. Facultas haec a Sacra Congregatione de Seminariis et studiorum Universitatibus, quae nunc Congregatio de Institutione Catholica (de Seminariis atque Studiorum Institutis) appellatur (*infra* - Congregatio) die XIX mensis Aprilis A. D. MCMXXVIII canonice approbata est. Hac decisione a Pio PP. XI confirmata atque ad executionem mandata, eadem Sacra Congregatio, innitens Decreto „*Lithuaniae antistites*“ diei XV mensis Iunii A. D. MCMXXVIII, declaravit in urbe Kaunas Facultatem Theologiae – Philosophiae canonice erectam esse cum iure conferendi gradus academicos Theologiae et Philosophiae. Eidem Facultati etiam alia privilegia concessa sunt, quibus huiusmodi Athenaea a Sede Apostolica erecta frui solent.

1930 m. Lietuvos universitetas buvo pavadintas Vytauto Didžiojo universitetu.

Anno MCMXXX Universitas Lithuaniae Universitas Vytauti Magni appellata est.

Teologijos-filosofijos fakultetas, būdamas Vytauto Didžiojo universiteto dalimi, savo veiklą plėtojo iki 1940 m. liepos 16 dienos. Lietuvą okupavus Sovietų Sąjungai, Fakultetas atskirtas nuo pasaulietiškojo universiteto. Kongregacijai sutikus, Teologijos-filosofijos fakultetas buvo perkeltas į Kauno tarpdiecezinę kunigų seminariją, tapo savarankiškas ir globojamas Fakulteto Didžiojo kanclerio bei Lietuvos ordinarų.

MCMXL, quando post occupationem Lithuaniae ab Unione Sovietica factam supradicta Facultas ab Universitate civili separata est. Cum consensu Congregationis Facultas Theologiae – Philosophiae translata est in Seminarium Interdioecesanum Kaunense, ubi sui iuris facta atque in tutelam Cancellarii Magni et Ordinariorum Lithuaniae recepta est.

Kadangi trūko kvalifikuotų filosofijos dėstytojų, 1953 m. Fakultetas tapo tik Teologijos fakultetu.

Anno MCMLIII Facultas, priva idoneis philosophiae Docentibus, Facultas tantum Theologiae esse coepit.

1989 m. balandžio 28 d. Lietuvos ir lietuvių išeivių mokslininkų konferencijoje „*Tautinė aukštosios mokyklos koncepcija ir Kauno universitetas*“ atkurtas Vytauto Didžiojo universitetas. 1990 m. vasario 28 d. Vytauto Didžiojo universiteto Senato nutarimu atkurtas Teologijos-filosofijos fakultetas. Šiam nutarimui pritarė Lietuvos Vyskupų Konferencija.

Die XXVIII mensis Aprilis A. D. MCMLXXXIX homines docti ex Lithuania et Exsilio Lithuano convenerunt in Conferentiam „Nationalis conceptio scholae superioris et Universitas Kaunensis“, ubi declaratus est actus, quo Universitas Vytauti Magni restituta est. Die XXVIII mensis Februarii A. D. MCMXC Senatus Universitatis Vytauti Magni decrevit, ut Facultas Theologiae – Philosophiae restauraretur. 1994 m. gegužės mėn. 10 d. Kongregacija pasiūlė, kad Kaune būtų vienas kanoniškai patvirtintas Teologijos fakultetas. 1994 m. gegužės 24 d. Lietuvos Vyskupų

Konferencijos ir 1994 m. birželio 1 d. Vytauto Didžiojo universiteto Senato sprendimu nutarta Vytauto Didžiojo universiteto Teologijos-filosofijos fakultetą ir Kauno teologijos fakultetą, esantį Kauno tarpdiecezinėje kunigų seminarijoje, pertvarkyti į vieną Katalikų teologijos fakultetą Vytauto Didžiojo universitete.

Die X mensis Maii A. D. MCMXCIV a Congregatione commendatum est, ut in urbe Kaunas unica Facultas Theologiae canonice approbata vigeret. Decreto a Conferentia Episcopali Lithuaniae die XXIV mensis Maii A. D. MCMXCIV facto ac decreto a Senatu Universitatis Vytauti Magni die I mensis Iunii A. D. I. Bendrieji nuostatai

Normae generales

1. Katalikų teologijos fakultetas (*toliau* – KTF arba Fakultetas) Vytauto Didžiojo universitete (*toliau* – VDU) yra VDU akademinis padalinys, vykdomas katalikų teologijos ir religijos mokslų studijas bei tyrimus.

Facultas Theologiae Catholicae (*infra* – FTC sive Facultas) apud Universitatem Vytauti Magni (*infra* – UVM) est pars academica UVM pro studiis et investigationibus Theologiae Catholicae atque disciplinarum Religionis exsequendis.

2. KTF vadovaujasi Lietuvos Respublikos mokslo ir studijų įstatymu, Bažnytinės teisės kodekso normomis, apaštališkąją konstituciją „*Veritatis Gaudium*“, paskelbta 2017 m. gruodžio 8 d., šios konstitucijos vykdymo nuorodomis („*Ordinationes*“) (*toliau* – Nuorodos), paskelbtomis 2017 m. gruodžio 27 d. ir kitais Šventojo Sosto dokumentais bažnytiniais universitetams bei fakultetams, VDU statutu ir šiuo statutu.

4. Pagrindiniai KTF tikslai yra šie:

- 2) vykdyti mokslinę veiklą ir mokyti studentus filosofijos bei teologijos disciplinų, laikantis Apaštališkosios konstitucijos „*Veritatis Gaudium*“ (art. 69–73) ir jos Nuorodų („*Ordinationes*“) (art. 53–56);
actionem scientificam exercere et Studentes instituere modo proprio disciplinis philosophicis et theologicis ad normas Constitutionis Apostolicae „Veritatis Gaudium“ (art. 69–73) et Ordinationum eidem Constitutioni Apostolicae annexarum (art. 53–56);
- 3) supažindinti studentus su Katalikų Bažnyčios mokymu, parengti teologijos ir religijos studijų specialistus, formuoti kvalifikuotus Bažnyčios darbuotojus, ugdyti katalikiškąją inteligentiją;
Studentes in doctrina Ecclesiae Catholicae altius instituere, peritissimos Theologiae et studiorum Religionis praeparare, formationem idoneorum habiliūque ministrorum Ecclesiae promovere necnon catholicos doctos atque intelligentes educare;
- 4) sudaryti studentams galimybę studijuoti disciplinas, skirtas bendrajai erudicijai ugdyti, nepažeidžiant filosofijos studijų integralumo pirmosios pakopos teologijos studijose (*VG art. 74 a*);
studentibus concedere potestatem studendi disciplinas, quae ad eruditionem communem ac doctrinalem sibi comparandam pertinent, salvo integro curriculo disciplinarum philosophicarum in studiis theologicis primi gradus (*VG art. 74 a*);

5) remti evangelizaciją vietinėje ir visuotinėje Bažnyčioje, glaudžiai bendradarbiaujant su Bažnyčios hierarchija.

5. KTF pedagoginis ir mokslo personalas vykdo mokslinius tyrinėjimus ir su jų rezultatais supažindina visuomenę.

6. Prie KTF gali jungtis ir kitos katalikiškos teologijos studijų institucijos, ypač Religijos studijų institutai. Jų jungimasis turi būti suderintas su Kongregacija ir VDU (VG art. 63-65; *Instrukcija dėl Religijos studijų institutų* art. 4).

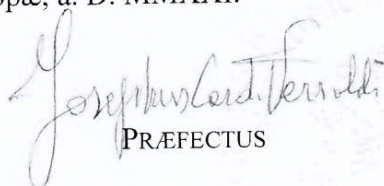

S T A T U T E S

The Faculty of Theology-Philosophy of the University of Lithuania in Kaunas was established on 12 April 1922. The faculty was canonically approved by the Vatican's Sacred Congregation for Catholic Education (seminaries and institutions of higher learning) (*hereinafter* – the Congregation) on 19 April 1928. When Pope Pius XI confirmed the decision and ordered that it be put into effect, the same Congregation announced, on the basis of the decree *Lithuaniae Antistites* of 15 June 1928, the existence in Kaunas of a canonically established Faculty of Theology-Philosophy having the right to confer academic degrees in theology and philosophy. The faculty was also granted other privileges which similar institutions established by the Holy See also enjoy.

In 1930, the University of Lithuania was renamed Vytautas Magnus University.

As a part of Vytautas Magnus University, the Faculty of Theology-Philosophy conducted its activities until 16 July 1940. Following the occupation of Lithuania by the Soviet Union, the faculty was separated from the secular university. With the approval of the Congregation, the Faculty of Theology-Philosophy was moved to the Kaunas Interdiocesan Seminary, becoming autonomous under the tutelage of the grand chancellor of the faculty and the ordinaries of Lithuania.

Due to a lack of qualified philosophy lecturers, in 1953 the faculty became a faculty of theology only.

On 28 April 1989, Vytautas Magnus University was re-established during a scientific conference of Lithuanian and Lithuanian-emigrant academicians titled “The National Concept of a School of Higher Education and the University of Kaunas”. The Faculty of Theology-Philosophy was re-established by a decree of the Senate of Vytautas Magnus University of 28 February 1990. The Lithuanian Bishops' Conference approved that decree.

On 10 May 1994, the Congregation proposed that there be one canonically approved faculty of theology in Kaunas. It was decided, by a decision of the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference of 24 May 1994 and of the Senate of Vytautas Magnus University of 1 June 1994, to reorganize the Faculty of Theology-Philosophy at Vytautas Magnus

University and the Kaunas Theology Faculty at the Kaunas Interdiocesan Seminary into a single Faculty of Catholic Theology at Vytautas Magnus University.

At the request of the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference, on 15 October 1998 the Senate of Vytautas Magnus University authorised the creation of an Institute of Religious Studies at the Faculty of Catholic Theology, which the Congregation approved.

The Faculty of Catholic Theology conducts its activities in accordance with these statutes, which are approved by consensus of the Senate of Vytautas Magnus University, the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference and the Congregation, and with the Statute of Vytautas Magnus University, the norms of which apply to the extent they are not governed by these statutes.

I. General provisions

1. The Faculty of Catholic Theology (*hereinafter* – the FCT or the Faculty) at Vytautas Magnus University (*hereinafter* – VMU) is an academic division of VMU which conducts education and research on Catholic theology and religious studies.
2. The FCT shall abide by the Law on Higher Education and Research of the Republic of Lithuania, the norms of the Code of Canon Law, the Apostolic Constitution *Veritatis Gaudium* (*hereinafter* – *VG*) promulgated on 8 December 2017, the Norms of Application (*Ordinationes*) for that constitution (*hereinafter* – the Norms) published on 27 December 2017 as well as other documents of the Holy See for ecclesiastical universities and faculties, the Statute of VMU, and these statutes.
3. Clergy, religious and lay Catholics known to lead an upright life who have the required education and the Church's recommendation may study at the FCT (*VG*, article 31).
4. The main goals of the FCT are:
 - 1) to seek that Catholic doctrine, derived with deep study from Divine Revelation, be considered and systematically explained using scientific methods, and that light be shed on the problems of our day based on Divine Revelation (*VG*, article 69);

- 2) to conduct research activities and teach students the disciplines of philosophy and theology in accordance with the Apostolic Constitution *Veritatis Gaudium* (articles 69-73) and its Norms of Application (*Ordinationes*) (articles 53-56);
 - 3) to acquaint students with the teaching of the Catholic Church, prepare specialists in theology and religious studies, train qualified Church workers, and form a Catholic intelligentsia;
 - 4) to offer students an opportunity to study disciplines intended to develop general erudition, without infringing on the cohesiveness of the philosophy studies in the first-cycle theology studies (*VG*, article 74 a);
 - 5) to support the work of evangelization in the local and the universal Church in close collaboration with the Church's hierarchy.
5. The teaching and research staff of the FCT shall engage in scientific research and make the results available to the public.
 6. Other institutions for the study of Catholic theology may also be incorporated into the FCT, particularly Institutes for Religious Studies. Their incorporation must be coordinated with the Congregation and VMU (*VG*, articles 63-65; instruction "Reform of the Higher Institutes of Religious Sciences", article 4).
 7. The FCT shall collaborate with Lithuanian and foreign ecclesiastical and secular faculties and with other scientific institutions.
 8. The FCT shall be looked after by the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference, to which the Grand Chancellor each year shall submit a report about the situation and activities of the Faculty (Code of Canon Law, cc. 809-813).
 9. A common library of the Kaunas Seminary and the Faculty, known as the Theology Faculty Library, shall operate at the FCT.
 10. The funds and assets of the FCT shall be managed, overseen, and used by mutual agreement of VMU and the Church.

11. In handling matters of violations of academic ethics, the FCT shall abide by the Code of Ethics of VMU to the extent that it does not oppose these statutes.
12. Decisions on matters of key importance with regard to the FCT shall be made by mutual agreement of the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference and VMU.

II. Management of the Faculty

13. The activities of the FCT shall be organized by:
 - 1) The Grand Chancellor;
 - 2) The Faculty Council;
 - 3) The Dean of the Faculty;
 - 4) The Dean's Committee – an advisory body led by the Dean.
14. The Grand Chancellor of the FCT shall be the current ordinary of the Kaunas Archdiocese. The Grand Chancellor shall be the representative of the Holy See at the Faculty of Catholic Theology and the representative of the FCT at the Holy See.
15. The Grand Chancellor shall:
 - 1) look after the FCT, its relations with the local and universal Church, and its preservation of the purity of the Catholic faith;
 - 2) supervise that the regulations of the Holy See and the provisions of these statutes are faithfully kept;
 - 3) ask the Holy See to confirm the candidate to be Dean of the Faculty;
 - 4) request the *nihil obstat* of the Congregation for candidates proposed by the FCT to receive the titles of Honorary Professor and Professor Emeritus;
 - 5) grant the canonical mission or give permission to teach to the Faculty's Dean, Vice-Dean and teachers, being able also to rescind such powers for these reasons:
 - for violations of Catholic morals or doctrine;
 - if inability to teach or to lead is established;

- 6) ask the Congregation to confirm (with a declaration of *nihil obstat*) teachers and research staff in disciplines related to faith and morals before they begin work in such a position at the Faculty (VG, article 27 § 2);
 - 7) confirm heads of divisions of the FCT after consulting with the Rector of VMU;
 - 8) together with the Rector of VMU, co-sign diplomas for completion of first-cycle and second-cycle studies;
 - 9) submit the statutes of the FCT and amendments thereof to the Congregation for approval;
 - 10) inform the Congregation about affairs of the FCT and every five years send it a detailed report on the academic, moral, and economic situation of the Faculty, and its strategic plan, along with the Grand Chancellor's own judgement (Norms, article 9.7).
16. The Faculty Council shall be comprised of teaching and research staff delegated by the divisions of the Faculty under the principle of parity, the Dean, and the Vice Deans. Students of the Faculty shall make up at least 20 percent of the members of the Faculty Council. The chairperson of the Faculty Council shall be the Dean of the FCT (Norms, article 17.2).
17. The Faculty Council shall:
- 1) carry out the functions stipulated in the Statute of VMU;
 - 2) in coordination with the Congregation, consider and approve the FCT's programmes of studies;
 - 3) coordinate with the Grand Chancellor candidates to receive the pedagogical titles of Associate Professor and Professor, and candidates to receive the titles of Professor Emeritus, Honorary Doctor and Honorary Professor, and present its opinion to the Senate of VMU;
 - 4) look after the contents of Catholic studies, the moral level of the Faculty community, and scientific progress.

18. The Dean of the FCT, carrying out the requirements of these statutes and the Statute of VMU as well as the will of the Faculty Council, shall lead the Faculty, act in its name, represent it and be responsible for its assets.
19. Candidates for Dean of the FCT shall be proposed from among academics by the Rector and approved by the Senate. The candidacy must be coordinated with the Congregation.
20. Election of the Dean of the FCT shall proceed as follows:
 - 1) The Faculty Council shall elect, by secret vote, two or three candidates for the position of Dean of the Faculty who have a pedagogical title and academic degree and meet the requirements of *Veritatis Gaudium* (VG, article 17).
 - 2) The Grand Chancellor shall with the Bishops' Conference consider those candidates elected by the Faculty Council and send them to the Congregation for approval. The Grand Chancellor shall present approved candidates to the Rector of VMU, who shall present them to the Senate of VMU for confirmation. The Grand Chancellor shall present the Dean approved by the VMU Senate to the Congregation for confirmation.
21. The Dean of the Faculty shall be confirmed for a five-year term. The Dean's term shall coincide with the duration of the Rector's powers. Seminary rectors may not be elected Dean of the Faculty.
22. The Dean of the Faculty shall:
 - 1) perform the functions stipulated in the Statute of VMU;
 - 2) implement resolutions adopted by the Congregation, the Senate and the Faculty Council as well as orders of the Rector;
 - 3) receive the profession of faith (*professio fidei*) of persons newly taking up positions as lecturers in areas related to faith and morals or pursuing a doctoral degree at the Faculty;
 - 4) report to the Grand Chancellor regarding the activities of the Faculty;

- 5) at least once a year update the Faculty's data in the online database of the Congregation (Norms, article 17.6).

III. Teaching and research staff

23. Teaching and research positions at the Faculty in areas concerning faith and morals may be held by persons who meet the requirements set out in VMU's Statute and approved by its Senate, and who have received a canonical mission (*missio canonica*) from the Grand Chancellor and made the profession of faith (*professio fidei*) (VG, article 27 § 1).
24. A Dean, Vice-Dean or other teaching or research employee of the FCT from whom the Grand Chancellor rescinds the canonical mission or permission to teach may no longer work at the Faculty.
25. Teachers of disciplines concerning faith and morals shall look after the spiritual formation of the students of the FCT.

IV. Organisation of studies

26. The FCT conducts: a five-year first cycle of philosophy and theology studies, successful completion of which brings the conferral of a bachelor's degree in Catholic theology (VG, article 74 a); a two-year second cycle of studies, successful completion of which brings the conferral of a licentiate degree in theology; and doctoral studies, four years in length, successful completion of which brings the conferral of the degree of doctor in theological sciences (VG, article 74 b-c).
27. Admission to studies at the Faculty is open to Catholics who are known for their upright life and have the recommendation of a Catholic priest.
28. Admission to licentiate studies in theology requires a bachelor's degree in theology, while admission to doctoral studies requires a licentiate degree in theology. Clergy

and religious who desire to study at the FCT must have the consent of their proper ordinary or religious superior.

29. In conducting its programmes of studies, the FCT brings together and coordinates the requirements established by VMU and by the Congregation.
30. First-cycle studies end with the preparation and defence of a bachelor's thesis. Licentiate studies end with a final exam "*ex tota theologia*" and the preparation and defence of a licentiate thesis. Doctoral studies end with a "*lectio coram*" exam, which must be passed to obtain the right to defend a doctoral dissertation.
31. Students of the Faculty may be removed from the rolls of students:
- 1) in the manner set out in the Study Regulations of VMU;
 - 2) if their moral life and doctrine are incompatible with the requirements of Catholic morals and the teaching of the Catholic Church.
32. Students of the FCT must attend the lectures, seminars, and other activities of the disciplines of their specialisation (VG, article 41).

V. Reorganisation and liquidation of the Faculty

1. Reorganisation or liquidation of the Faculty shall be by mutual agreement of VMU and the Church.

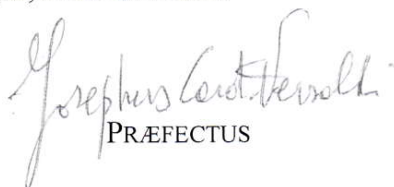
